#### Mid-Autumn Festival

Mid-Autumn Festival, Zhongqiu Jie (中秋节) in Chinese, is also called the Moon Festival or the Mooncake Festival. It is the second most important festival in China after <u>Chinese New Year</u>. During this time, families come together to enjoy dinner and spend time with each other, much like Thanksgiving. Chinese people also celebrate by lighting paper lanterns, worshipping the moon, and eating mooncakes, which are the most symbolic food for this festival. Mooncakes are round in shape and have a sweet flavor that represents completeness and sweetness. It is customary to share mooncakes with family and friends as a way to express love and best wishes. Typically, mooncakes are enjoyed after dinner while admiring the beauty of the moon.

Please allow your child to dress in either traditional Chinese attire, any other traditional costume, or comfortable home clothes on Friday, September 29<sup>th</sup>. We will commemorate the festival by having our teachers act out the story of Chang'e and Hou Yi, followed by a mooncake, pomelo tasting, and festival-themed games. I appreciate your cooperation.
